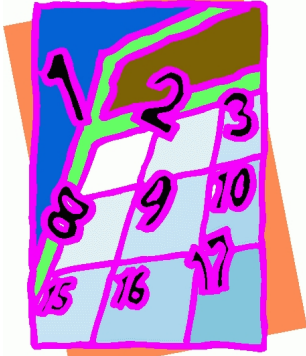

don't want to compare multiple calendars with each other every time I add an event to my own personal calendar.

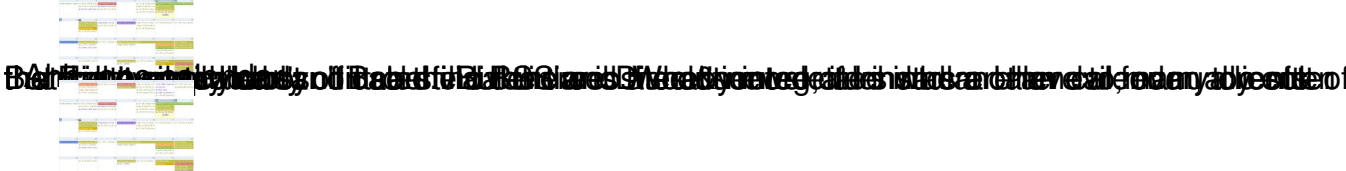
