We be geekin again. Three years ago we moved from Philadelphia to San Jose and looked like this:

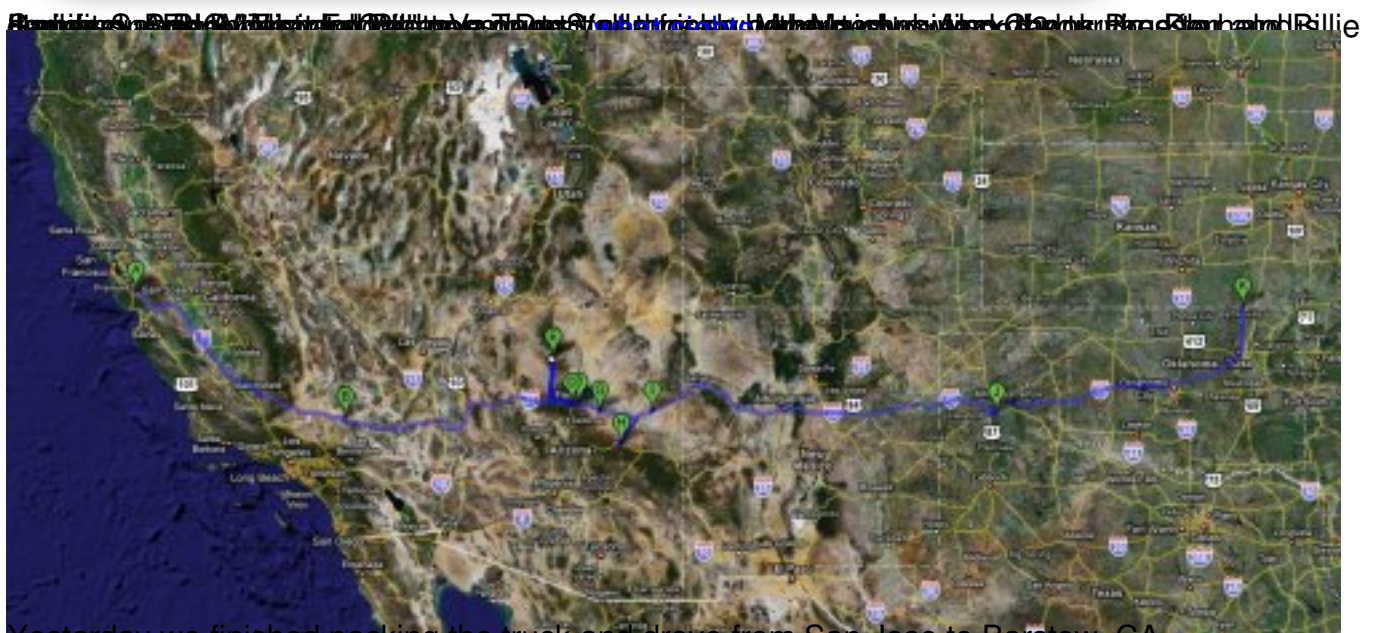


Now we're moving to Caney, KS, and still look a little funny:

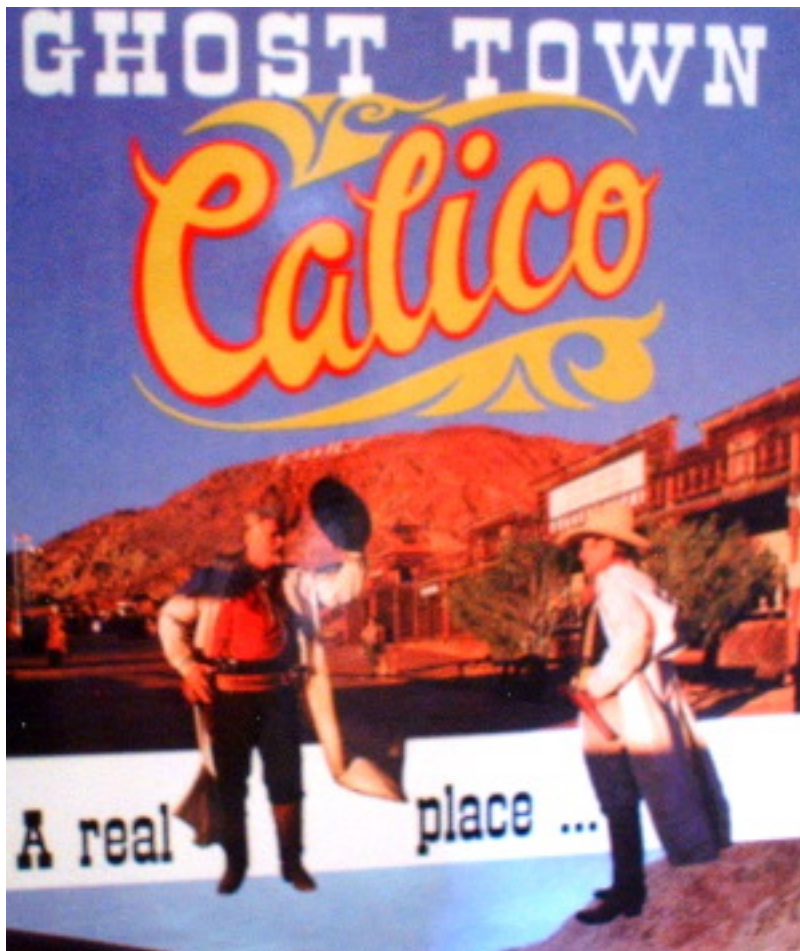
